Objectives, structure and contents of our MOOC

As we wrote in the Train the Trainer Manual "within the framework of the activities planned in the "Care Path Project" the prerogative is to provide training on the fundamental principles that characterize this field, paying particular attention to the psychological, juridical/legal and scientific research dimensions. In particular, the training course is offered to all those working in this area of interest, but not only, and also to whom have various skills and competences. It takes into account the fact that they may have responsibilities and areas of action that vary according to the role and from country to country. Therefore, in the training course particular attention is paid to the fact that responsibilities and areas of interventions are regulated by different laws, regulations, codes of ethics of the various professions and associations and in accordance with internal regulations and treatment philosophies or scientific guidelines implemented by the different organizations. To this end, the modules that compose the course are specifically dedicated to an in-depth analysis of the essential aspects of TIC; they are divided into thematic sections organized in line with a specific and multi-dimensional perspective with a further focus on the political and organizational components involved in the complex TIC model" and then "the course is dedicated to all people interested in deepening the issues related to good practices in interventions focused on trauma dedicated to children who have a history of development made complex by traumatic events.

The training program is developed in several languages: English, Italian, French, Hungarian and Greek; it has an 8-week overall duration: a total of 60 hours of commitment for the participant (8 hours per week)".

Some data from the MOOCs' participants

One of the pages available to trainers and instructors are the summary pages on the progress of all participants.

Here is an example of a couple of summary pages for the Italian and Greek MOOCs where you can see the numbers of registered participants, the number of trainers and instructors (the label used is Audit), the start date, the end date and the language in which the MOOC is delivered and whether there are any activities to be carried out for the students.

The total number of those enrolled in the 5 MOOCs was 1317 of which 18.4% were male and 80.5% female and 1.1% stated other. The mean age is 34.62 years with a standard deviation of 12.211 years (M: 76; m: 21).

Successful participants. Finished all the course activities including Video lectures, Quizzes, and the final assignment. All successful participants were eligible for claiming their certificate through the CAREPATH platform.

Engaged Participants. Engaged in at least on Quiz Activity and Video Lecture but did not manage to finish the course.



Completion rate. The share of the users who successfully finished all MOOC learning activities.

Retention rate. The share of the users that were active.

Dropout rate. The share of participants that did not actively engaged in the MOOC activities.

According to class central, during 2020, the big MOOC providers got bigger launching over 2800 courses, 360 microcredentials/micromasters and 19 online degrees mainly due to the so-called quarantine boost ¹. However, the completion rates in the MOOC world are low lying within **an 8% up to 20%**.

A 2018 Columbia University's Teachers College study on edX and Coursera courses concluded that the certificate-based MOOCs reached a completion rate of **15**% ². Another source shows that completion rates are averaging **15**% with top outliers reaching a **40**%³. A recent study by MIT in 2009 revealed that MOOCs reached a disappointing **drop out rate of 95**% over the last 5 years⁴.

The CAREPATH partnership was aware from the very beginning that the engagement of the learners through an online learning offering (including numerous Quizzes, peer reviews and a project-like assignment) would be a very challenging task. The CarePath MOOC reached a 42.09% retention and in combination with the huge number of enrolments is considered as a strong indicator of success.

Approximately 59% of the enrolled students attend the MOOC in Italian language as shown in the graphs below.

Below is the graph with the different qualifications entered on the personal pages and we can see that the majority of those attending have a Master's Degree and then move on to a Bachelor's Degree and a High School.

Below are the minimum, maximum, mean and standard deviation scores obtained at all quizzes, of which there are 11. It is important to highlight that along with the Quizzes a total of 400 assignments have been assessed by the CarePath instructors



while more than 400 peer reviews took place (some participants reviewed more than one peer assignment).

CarePath YouTube analytics

The following data from the CarePath YouTube channel are referring to the Period that MOOCs were online, that is from 1/1/2020 up to 1/11/2020. The dedicated YouTube channel was created to host the video lectures that were embedded in the CarePath learning environment. The total number of video lectures was 79 while for all video lectures subtitles in the respective languages were created and embedded in each one of them. In total 31.8k views were recorded reaching a total Watch time of 2.1K hours. The following picture provides an overview of the activity over time.

An important number of participants were engaged through mobile devices (Watch time ~ 10%, ~204hours) highlighting the ease of use, and the responsiveness of the platform in rendering audio-visual material in mobile phones and tablets.

Finally, a list of the top 10 video lectures (per Watch time) is depicted in the following figure. The fact that the top video lecture reached a 3% of the total watch time reveals that more or less the majority of the video lectures were viewed by the participants.
